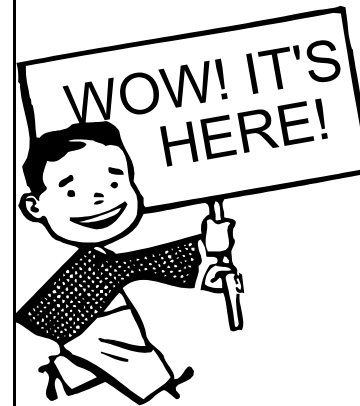

Pruning



Pruning your trees promotes its health by removing dead, diseased, damaged or hazardous branches, and by training and directing growth. Pruning also promotes flowering and fruiting habits.

For almost all deciduous trees, the best time to prune is after the leaves have fallen. No pruning should take place during bud break in the spring.

Conifer shaping should take place once the new foliage is fully extended but not necessarily hardened off, typically by May or June and no later, to avoid trimming off the buds for the next season's growth. Avoid removing more than one third per season.

Elms are provincially regulated and can only be pruned from October 15 to March 15 to prevent Dutch Elm Disease. The City is responsible for pruning Elm trees on the boulevards.
